



FIRST READING *Proclaimed in English. / Proclamada en Inglés.*

Ezekiel 37:1-14

En aquellos días, la mano del Señor se posó sobre mí, y su espíritu me trasladó y me colocó en medio de un campo lleno de huesos. Me hizo dar vuelta en torno a ellos. Había una cantidad innumerable de huesos sobre la superficie del campo y estaban completamente secos.

Entonces el Señor me preguntó: "Hijo de hombre, ¿podrán acaso revivir estos huesos?" Yo respondí: "Señor, tú lo sabes". Él me dijo: "Habla en mi nombre a estos huesos y diles: 'Huesos secos, escuchen la palabra del Señor. Esto dice el Señor Dios a estos huesos: He aquí que yo les infundiré el espíritu y revivirán. The entire assembly remains standing after the proclamation of the Gospel while the assisting deacon returns to the Archbishop with the Evangelary (Book of the Gospels). The Archbishop kisses the book and blesses the assembly with the Evangelary. They gesture themselves with the sign of the cross as the Archbishop raises the Evangelary to impart the blessing. All are then seated for the presentation.

THE ANOINTING WITH CHRISM

The Holy Chrism is brought forward and the Bishops go to the place where they will anoint the candidates. With their sponsors, the candidates now go to be anointed. The sponsors place their right hand on the shoulder of the one they present. With the Chrism, Archbishop Coyne and Bishop Betancourt anoint each candidate on the forehead.

In the anointing with Chrism and the accompanying words, the effect of the giving of the Holy Spirit is clearly signified. Signed with the perfumed oil by the hand of the Bishop, the baptized receive the indelible character, the seal of the Lord, together with the gift of the Spirit that conforms them more fully to Christ and gives them the grace of spreading among men and women “the pleasing fragrance of Christ.”

This makes clear the specific importance of confirmation for sacramental initiation by which the faithful "as members of the living Christ are incorporated into him and made like him through baptism and through confirmation and the eucharist." In baptism, the newly-baptized receive forgiveness of sins, adoption as children of God, and the character of Christ, by which they are made members of the Church and for the first time become sharers in the priesthood of their Savior.

Through the sacrament of confirmation, those who have been born anew in baptism receive the inexpressible Gift, the Holy Spirit, by which "they are endowed... with special strength." Moreover, having received the character of this sacrament, they are "bound more intimately to the Church" and "they are more strictly obliged to spread and defend the faith both by word and deed as true witnesses of Christ."

Finally, ... the faithful, after being signed by holy baptism and confirmation, are incorporated fully into the body of Christ by participation in the eucharist.
